This project will reconnect southside neighborhoods cut off by historic investments and ensure new projects **increase opportunity, advance** racial equity and environmental justice, and promote affordable access to community assets

CONNECTING

- Many of Dane County's most diverse neighborhoods to the Lake and Downtown
- Our largest convention center (Alliant Energy Center) and one of our largest lakefront parks (Olin-Turville Park)
- City and County owned facilities that will expand public access and community use

IMPACT

- Creates a safe pedestrian crossing of a highway in a growing pedestrian- and bike-oriented District and during our major regional events
- **Expands local destination-oriented jobs and boosts tourism** by integrating the District and Downtown for our largest community events
- Reduce auto congestion by seamlessly connecting our southside neighborhoods, convention center, and downtown
- Provides southside residents access to Lake Monona amenities
